Emboss Resist Sparkle Tutorial

The sparkle adds a pretty dimension to thee colorful cards

Finished Card:

Artist: Chris Dickinson
Stamps: Mark's Finest Papers



Supplies:

- VersaMark Pad
- Line Art Image
- Embossing Buddy/Anti-Static Pad
- Clear Embossing Powder
- Heat Tool
- Glitter Pens, clear or colored
- Neutral Cardstock
- 3 Dye Inks
- Sponge or Ink Applicator
- Soft Cloth or Paper Towel
- Stamps, Additional Card Stock and Embellishments



Step One:

Rub the anti-static pad across the neutral card stock.



Step Two:

Randomly stamp the line art image with VersaMark ink on the cardstock.



Step Three:

Sprinkle the clear embossing powder across the stamped card stock, tap off the excess and heat with the heat tool.



Step Four:

Sponge the lightest die ink randomly over the embossed images, leaving plenty of white space.



Step Five:

Next, randomly sponge the medium ink color in some of the uninked areas, blending the edges together.



Step Six:

Fill in the remaining spaces with the third color, blending the edges together.



Step Seven:

Gently wipe off any excess ink with the paper towel from the embossed areas.

Using the Glitter Pen, fill in the inside of the open image on the project. Mat and embellish as desired.

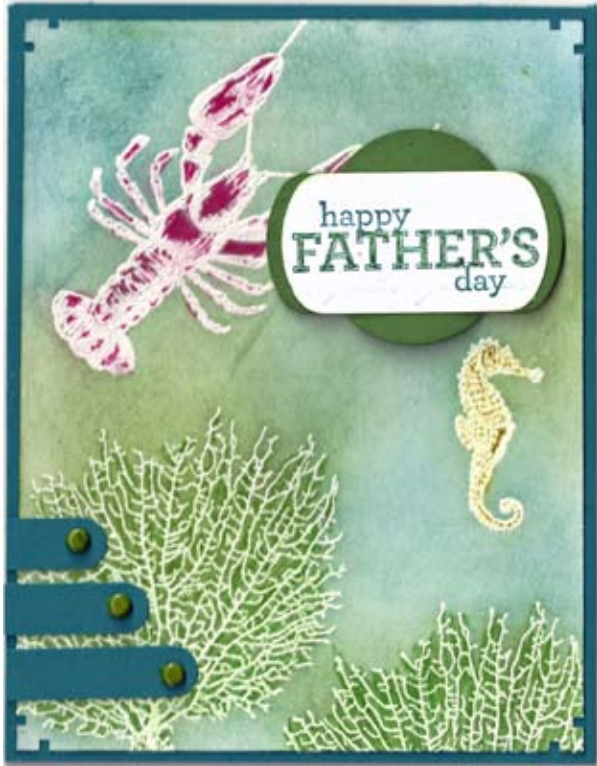
