

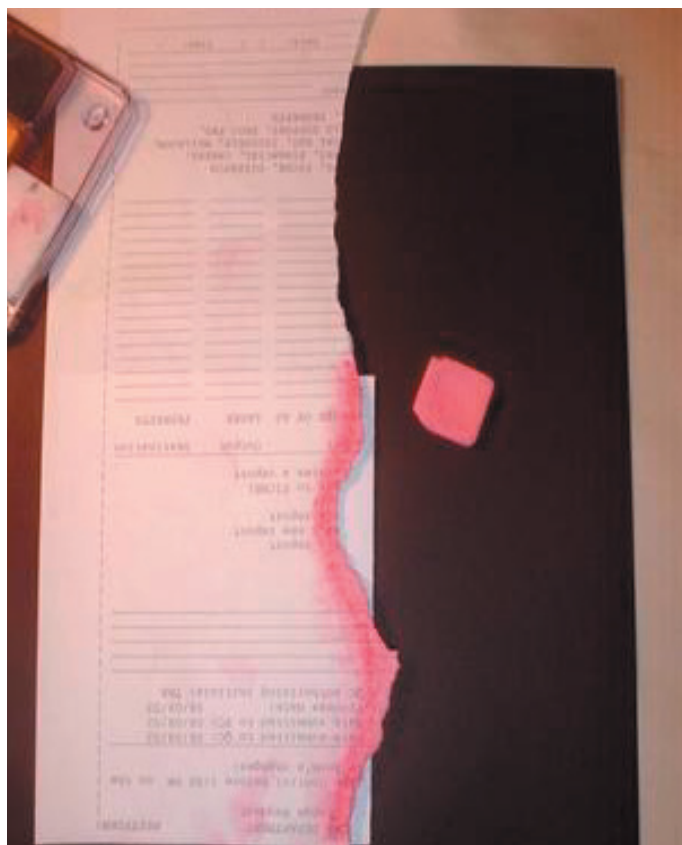

## Chalk Dragging Tutorial

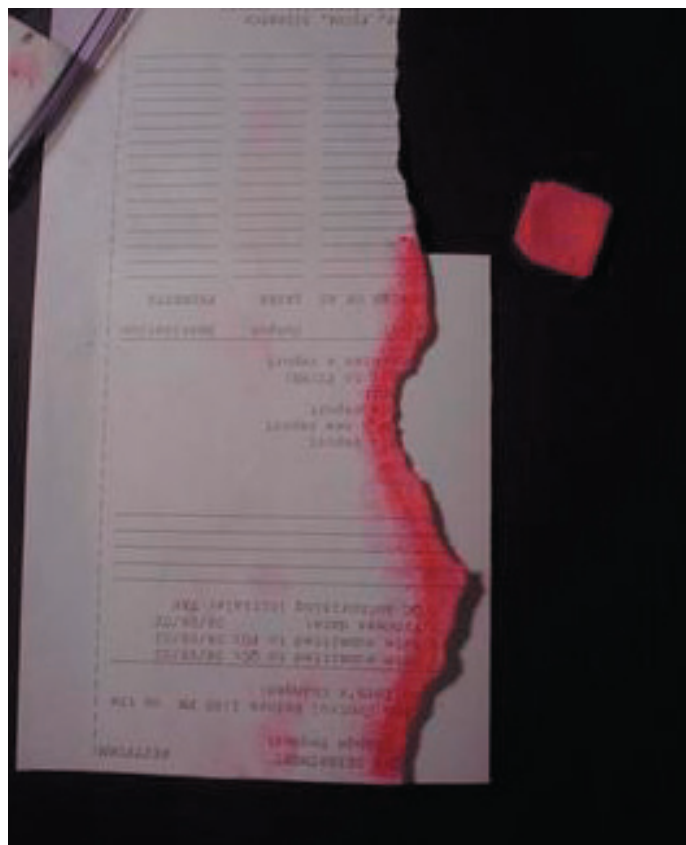

### Supplies

Scrap paper larger than A-2 size  
Cardstock  
Chalk  
Paint Brush  
Versamark pad



### Steps One & Two

Tear the long edge of your scrap paper (you may want to experiment with how jagged you make it.)

Using your finger or the edge of a chalk block, rub chalk along the jagged edge of the scrap paper. Be careful not to get chalk on the cardstock.

## Step Three & Four

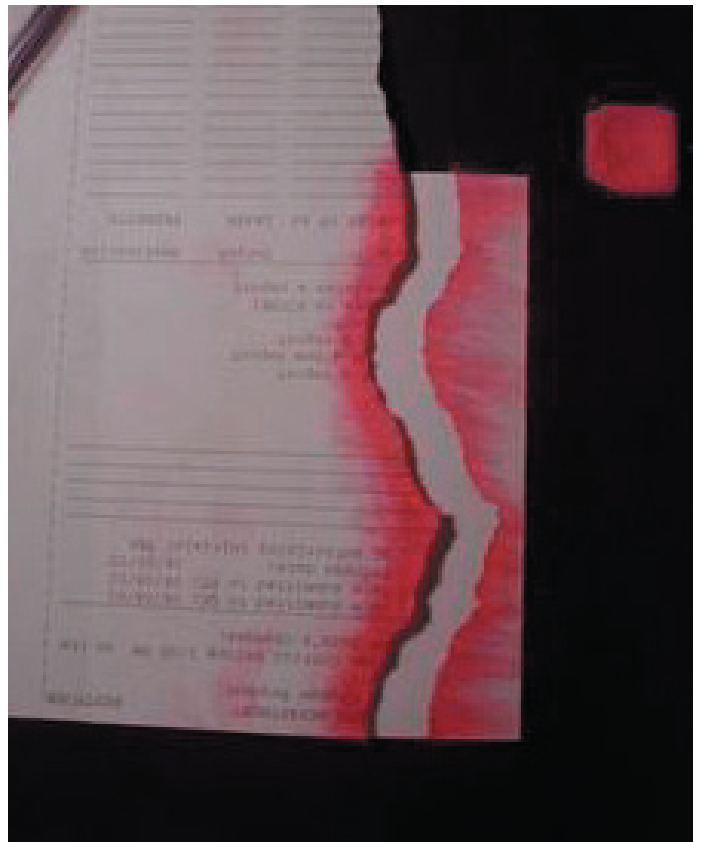
Carefully placed chalked edge on far edge of cardstock (scrap paper should be covering all but the edge showing).

Using your finger, drag the chalk from the scrap paper onto the card stock in a straight motion.



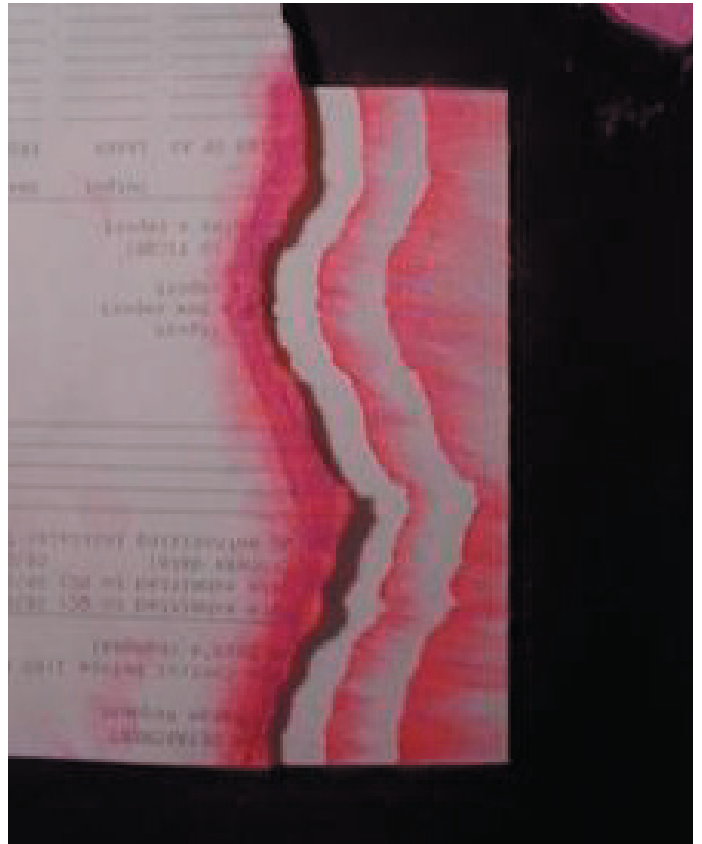
## Steps Five & Six

Lift the scrap paper up and move it over approximately  $\frac{3}{4}$  to 1 inch. Use your finger to rub more chalk onto the cardstock.

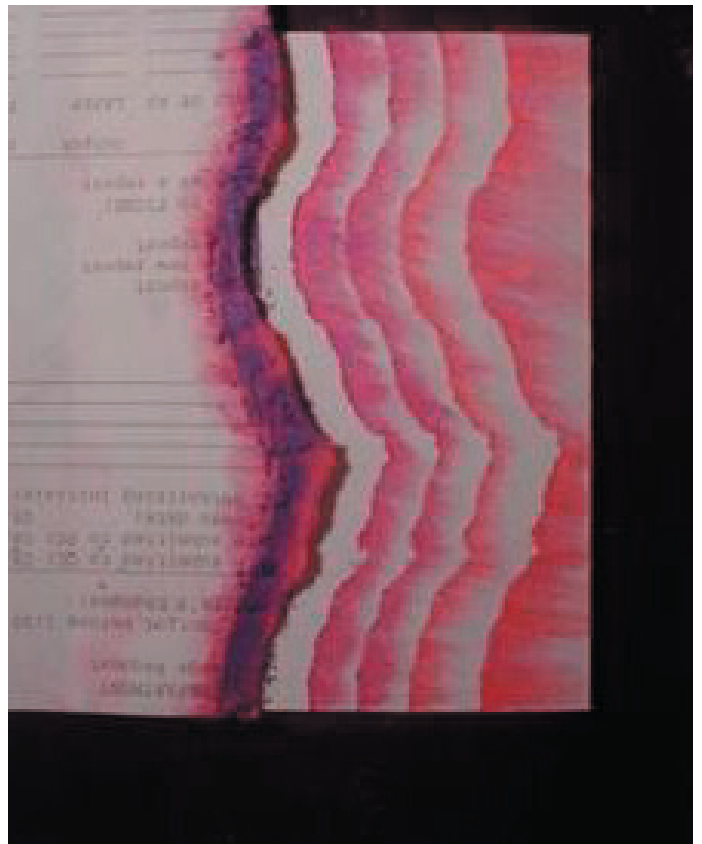


## Step Seven, Eight, & Nine

Re-chalk your scrap paper when most of the chalk has rubbed off. When working with multiple colors of chalk, start with the lightest color first.



Chalk over the same piece of scrap paper with the new color. This will help blend the colors.



## Steps Ten, Eleven, & Twelve

When all lines of colors are completed, use a paint brush to drag the chalk all the way across the cardstock. This pulls the chalk, giving the dragged effect, and blends the colors.

Ink your image with versamark and stamp it on the chalked cardstock.

Using your finger, drag the chalk across your image in the same direction. This will darken the versamarked image.

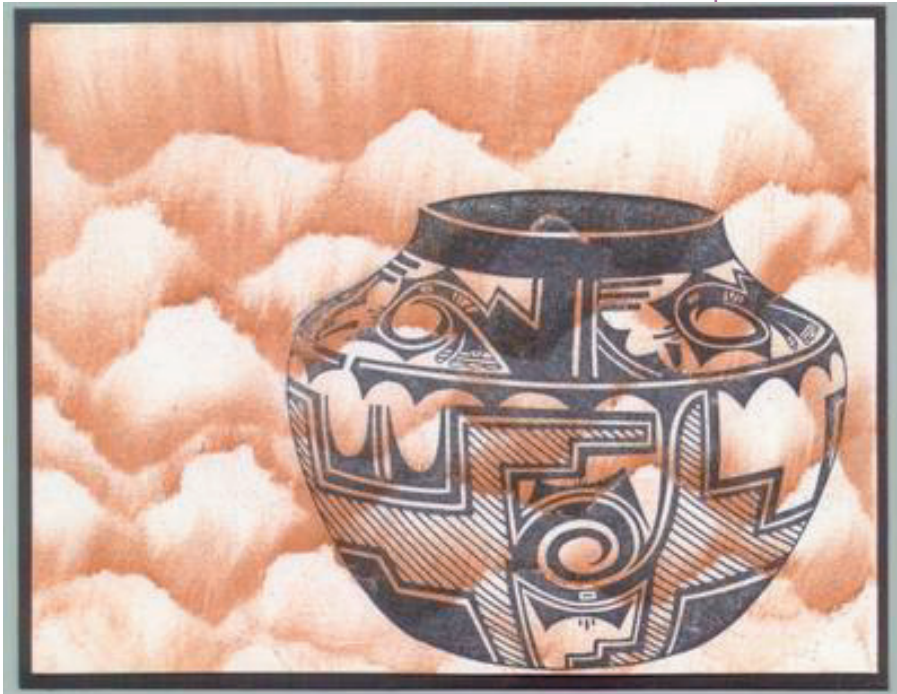
