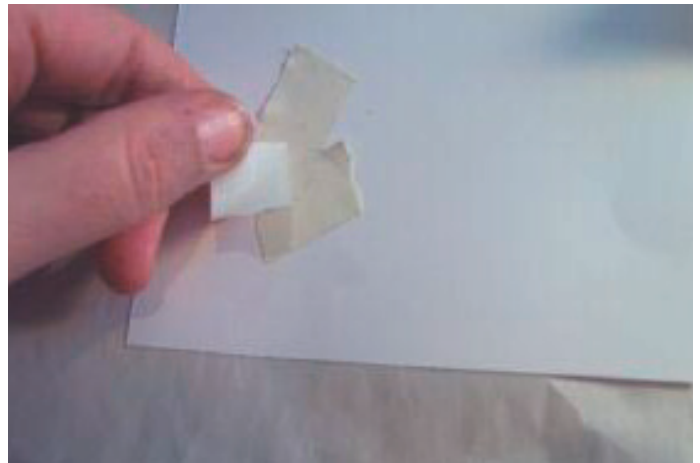
Masking Tape Tutorial April-May 2003 Newsletter



Supplies

Masking Tape
Cardstock
Metallic Ink Pad
Clear Embossing Powder

Heat tool
rainbow/spectrum/kaliedacolor
pad



Step One

Tear off small sections of masking tape, (approximately 1") and apply them to the cardstock randomly.



Step Two

Overlap all edges ensuring that the cardstock is covered completely.



Step Three

Pounce or drag the rainbow pad across the masking tape (use a combination of both pouncing and dragging for best results).



Step Five Through Eight

Dry ink somewhat with heat tool.
Apply metallic ink to the surface with a sponge, highlighting the highest points with the metallic ink.
Cover project with embossing powder and emboss.
Decorate card as desired.



Step Four

Using sponges and individual ink pads/colors, apply ink directly to masking tape. Using sponges will prevent your pads from getting "muddled."

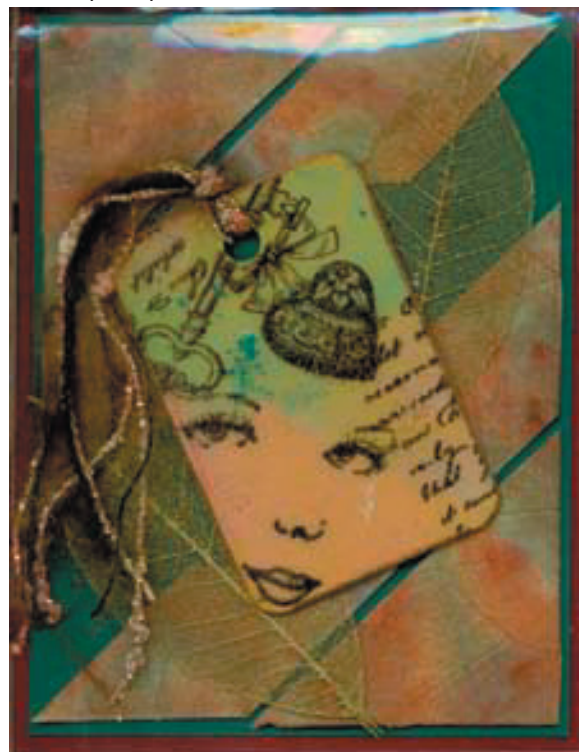
