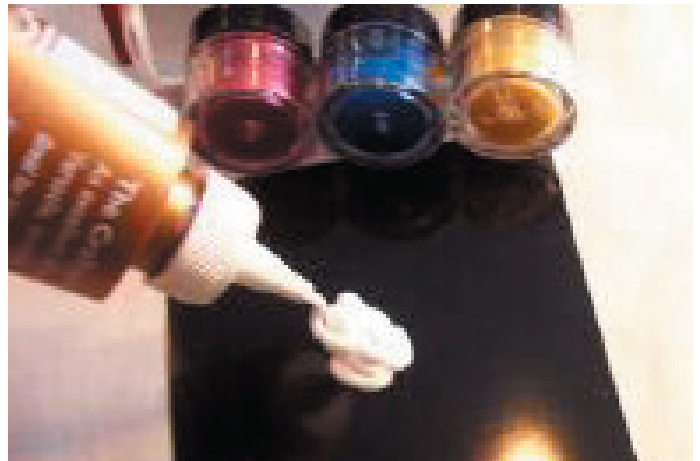
Pearl Ex Reverse Tutorial April-May 2003 Newsletter



Supplies

Perfect paper Adhesive or
Aleene's Tacky Glue
2 or 3 Colors Pearl Ex
Black Glossy Cardstock
Brayer

Solid Image Stamps
Stipple Brush



Step One

Squirt a half-dollar sized portion of PPA or glue onto black glossy cardstock.



Step Two

Spread around paper. Glue should be thick.



Steps Three

Drop 2 -3 colors of Pearl Ex into the glue.



Step Four

Brayer onto the card, making sure to leave the surface somewhat textured. You may want to use a "pouncing" motion, rather than a rolling motion. If you press too hard, you will pull too much of the mixture off and your work will look flat.

Step Five

Wash your brayer immediately!

Note

If desired, roll your brayer over another piece of clean cardstock for a cool background. Why waste the pearl ex?

Step Six through Eight

Press a dry solid stamp into the mixture on CS.
Twist stamp slightly as you lift up.
Allow to dry and layer as desired.

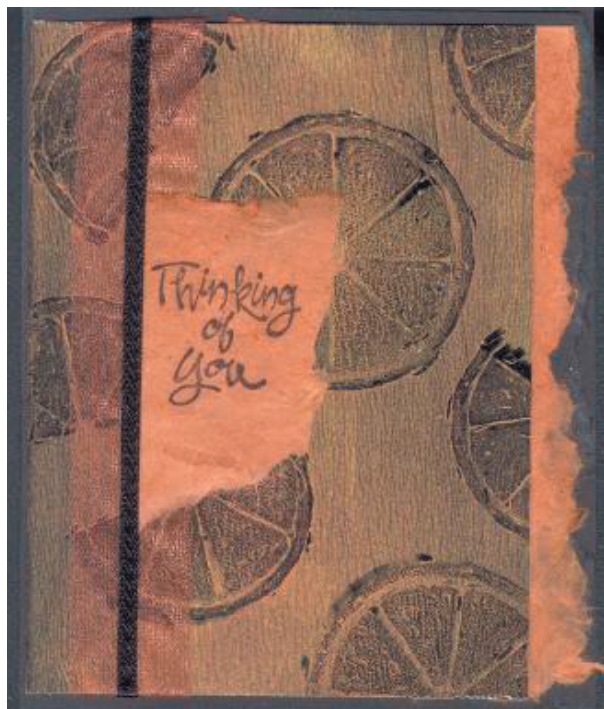
