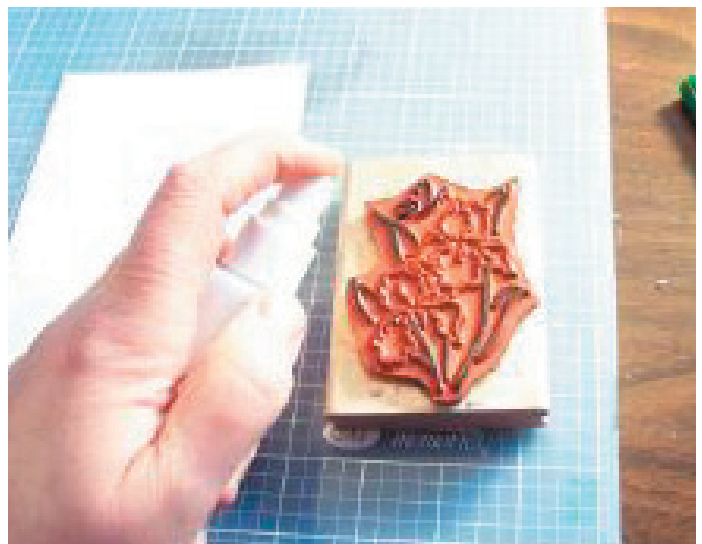


Supplies
Stamps
Water-Based Markers
Water in a spritz bottle
Matte cardstock or watercolor
paper



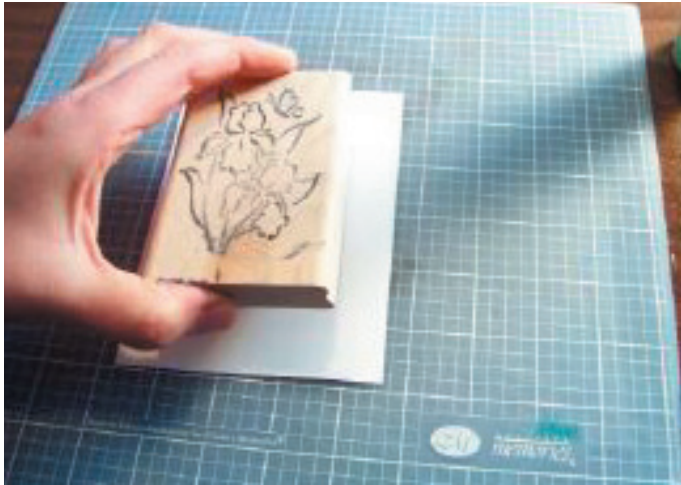
Step 1

Using markers, color the image directly on the stamp.



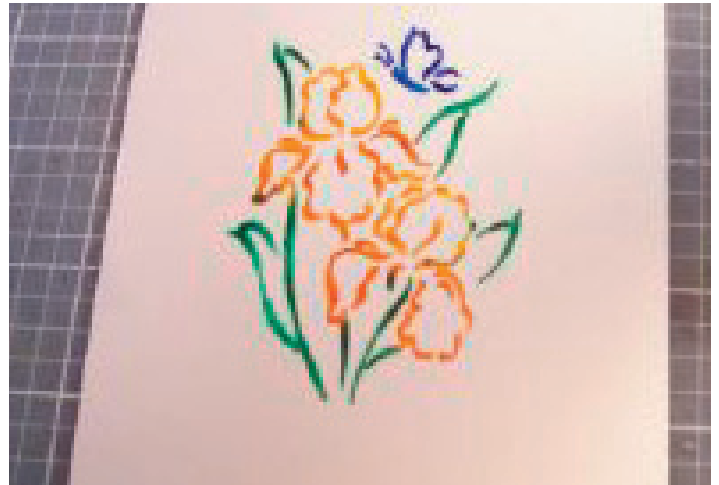
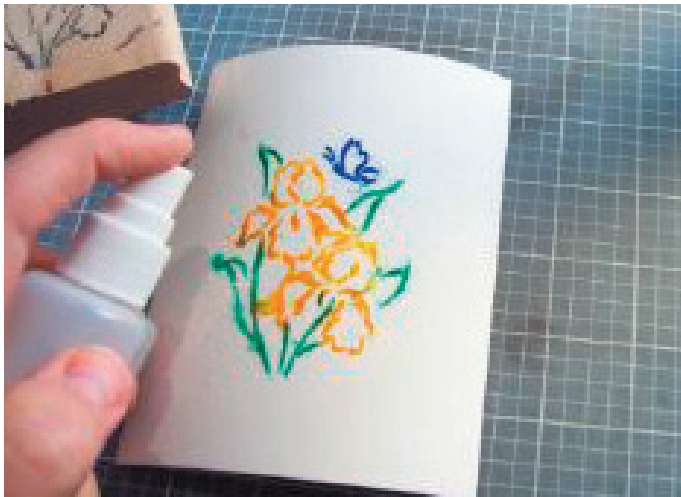
Step 2

Lightly spritz the stamp with water.



Step 3

Stamp image directly onto paper.



Step 4 - 6

For a softer look, spritz image lightly once again.

If desired, blot image with paper towel to absorb excess water.

Let dry. If cardstock curls, place under heavy book until flattened.

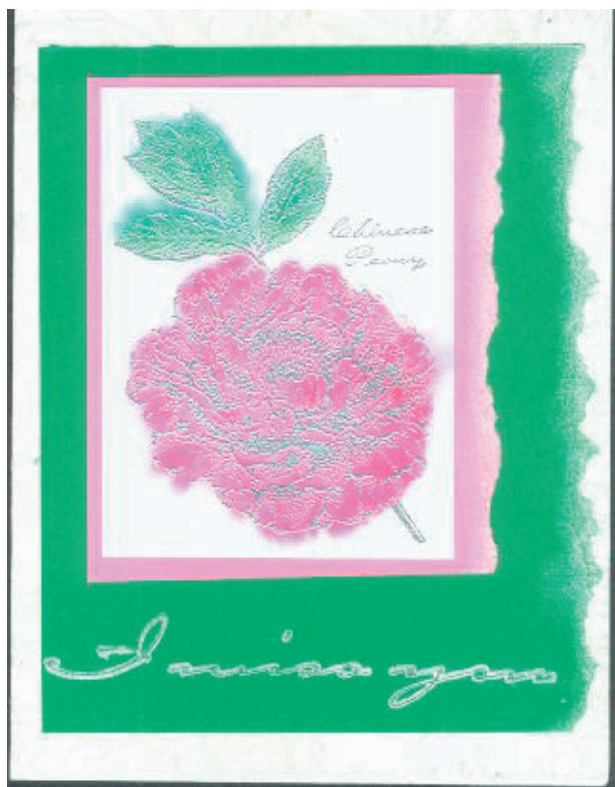
