Supplies

Masking tape
Stamps
Glossy cardstock
3 or more colors of ink
Sponges/make-up applicators

Step Two

Start to attach the tape on the glossy cardstock in a random fashion.



Step One

Tear off strips of masking tape. tear strips THINLY.

Note: Most people who do not like the look of their cards after trying this technique do not tear their tape thin enough! When you think it's thin enough, give it another tear!!!

To take some of the "stickiness" off the tape, attach to clothing or cloth, and then pull off -- some of the fibers will stick to the tape, and your cardstock will not be torn as easily when you remove it from the paper.





Step Three

Cover cardstock with tape until desired coverage is achieved.



Step Four

Sponge ink onto card with first color using make-up applicator.



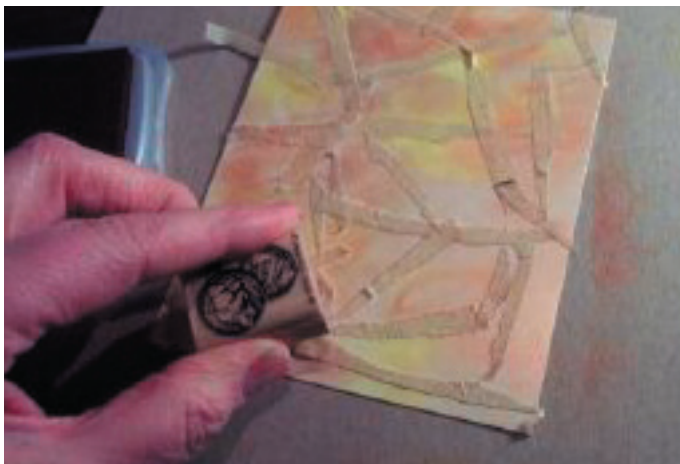
Step Five

Sponge on second color of ink.



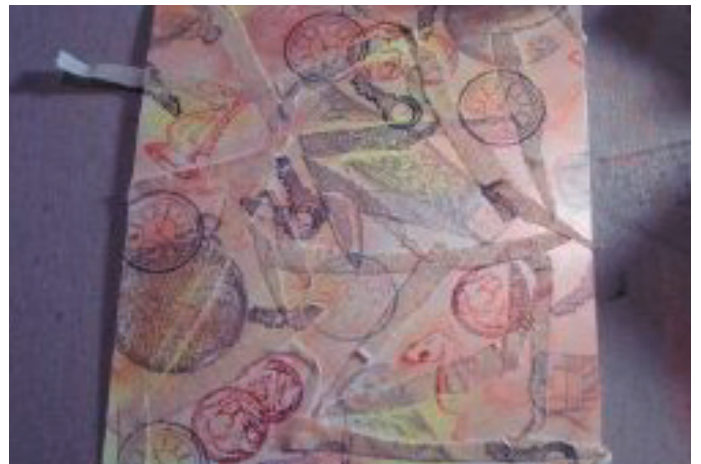
Step Six

Continue sponging on inks until desired color is achieved.



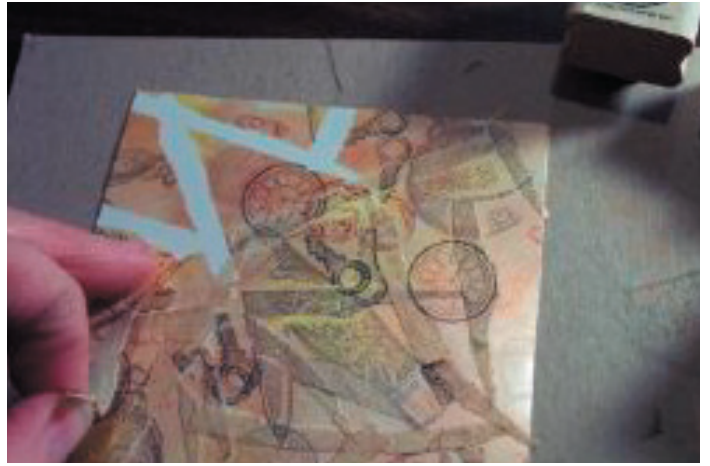
Step Seven

Stamp images over tape/ink. Collage-style stamping works well with this technique.



Step Eight

Remove masking tape carefully from cardstock.
Finish card and embellish as desired.
