Bands of Color Tutorial

Beth Norman filmed this colorful technique.




Supplies:

- Ink Pads
- Sponges
- Wide Sticky Notes
- White Cardstock



Step One:

Tear along the top of the sticky note to make the edges uneven. Lay the first sticky note so there is open space; sponge color onto the cardstock between the sticky notes.



Step Two:

To avoid color contamination, tear a new sticky note. To ensure a white band is left, place the sticky note a little below the first colored band. Use a fresh sticky note and tear as in previous step. Place below the first to create another band and sponge on another color.

Step Three:Continue adding white bands and adding color by placing the sticky notes below the colored bands. Repeat this process until the cardstock is fully colored.




Step Four: Embellish and finish as desired.
