Chalkboard Stamping Tutorial Holly Brown filmed this black and white technique. Word stamps work great to recreate

the look of a chalkboard.



Supplies:

- Stamp(s)
- Black Cardstock
- VersaMark Ink
- White Embossing Powder
- White Pencil
- White Ink Pad
- Heat Gun (not pictured)



Step One:

Ink the stamp(s) with VersaMark and press onto black cardstock. This tutorial uses multiple small stamps arranged on an acrylic block. One large stamp could be used or several smaller stamps can be combined.



Step Two:

Cover cardstock with white embossing powder, tap off excess, and melt powder with heat gun.



Step Three:

With the white pencil, doodle lines around the image and add extra lines, flourishes, and dots next to the stamped images.



Step Five:

Lightly rub inked finger around the edges of the black cardstock. Ink up your finger again and rub ink into the areas around the stamped images. Repeat as needed for desired result. Finish card as desired




Step Four:

Pick up ink with index finger by pressing finger into the white ink pad.




