Chevron Tutorial

These are all the rage - and it is so easy to cut your own! Filmed by Pat Huntoon.



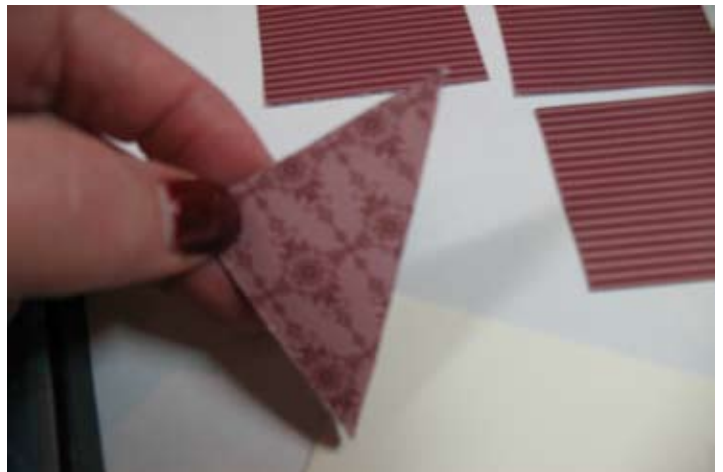
Supplies:

- Double-sided Designer Paper
- Trimmer
- Scissors
- Card Base
- Adhesive



Step One:

Create four 2" x 2" squares from the designer paper.



Step Two:

Fold one of the squares in half diagonally.



Step Three:

Fold the triangle in half again.

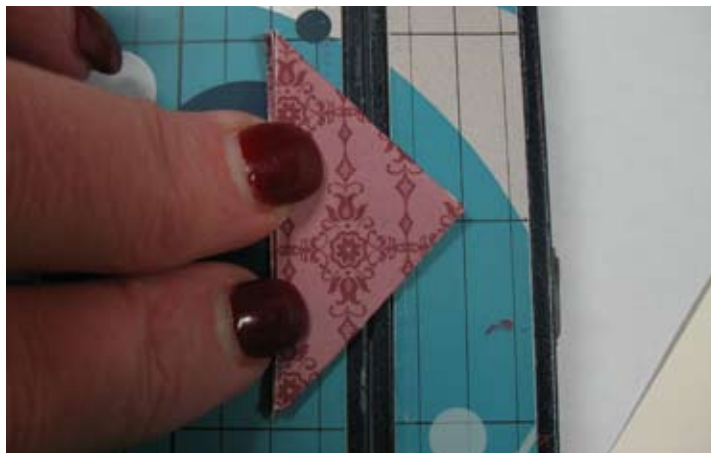


Step Four Continued



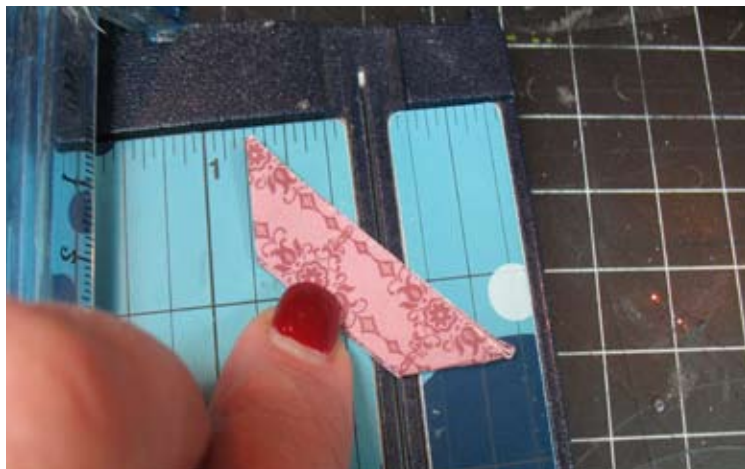
Step Six:

The cut creates two chevron pieces. Open each to use.



Step Four:

Align the long edge of the triangle up with the $\frac{1}{2}$ " vertical line on the paper trimmer. Cut off the end. Note: This is far easier with a guillotine trimmer. If the trimmer does not cut through, use a ruler and scissors to make the cut.

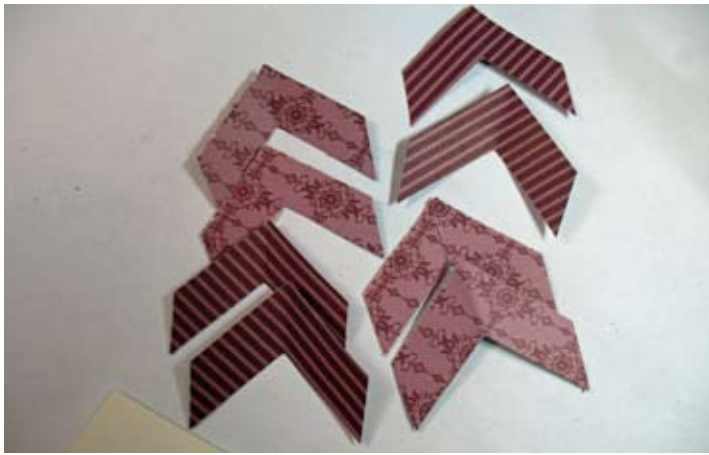


Step Five:

Align one of the short edges with the $\frac{3}{4}$ " vertical line on the trimmer. Cut the edge off, making a diagonal cut.

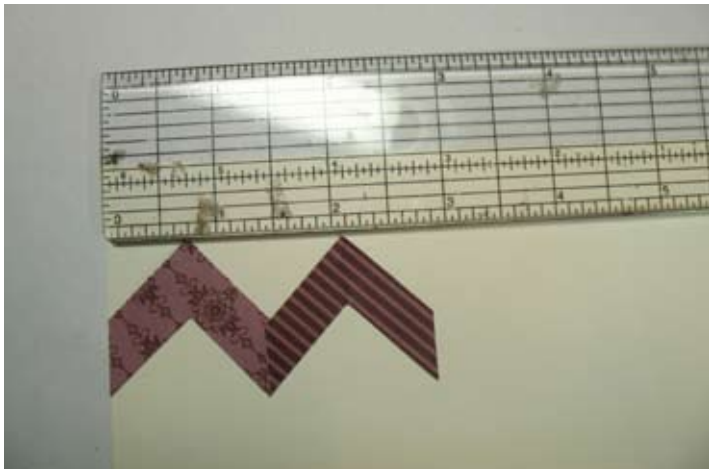

Step Seven:

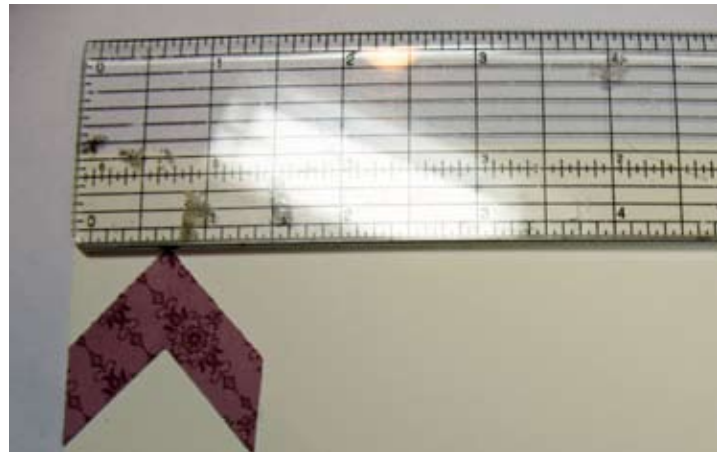
Repeat with the other squares to make 8 chevrons, Either side can be used.

Step Eight:

To use, align the edge of the chevron with the edge of the paper. Place the edge of the second chevron flush against the first. If desired, use a ruler to make sure that the top is aligned evenly.



Step Nine:

Add chevrons to create desired pattern. Finish card as desired.
