Copic Color Double Embossing Tutorial

Jane Bosi filmed this technique, which was originated by Sharon Harnist.



Supplies:

- Copic Airbrush
- Copic Markers
- Heat Tool
- Clear Embossing Powder
- VersaMark Ink
- White Cardstock
- Embossing Buddy
- Alcohol Wipe
- Embossing Folder
- Embossing Machine, not pictured



Step One:

Prepare cardstock with embossing buddy.



Step Two:

Place cardstock in embossing folder and emboss according to machine specifications.



Step Two Continued



Step Four:

Cover VersaMark ink with clear embossing powder.



Step Six:

Load Copic marker into airbrush tool..



Step Three:

Using a well inked VersaMark pad, gently ink the dry embossed image.



Step Five:

Remove excess embossing powder and heat emboss with the heat tool.



Step Seven:

Airbrush color onto embossed cardstock.



Step Eight:

Continue adding Copic ink until cardstock is completely colored.



Step Nine:

Use alcohol wipe to remove ink from embossed image.

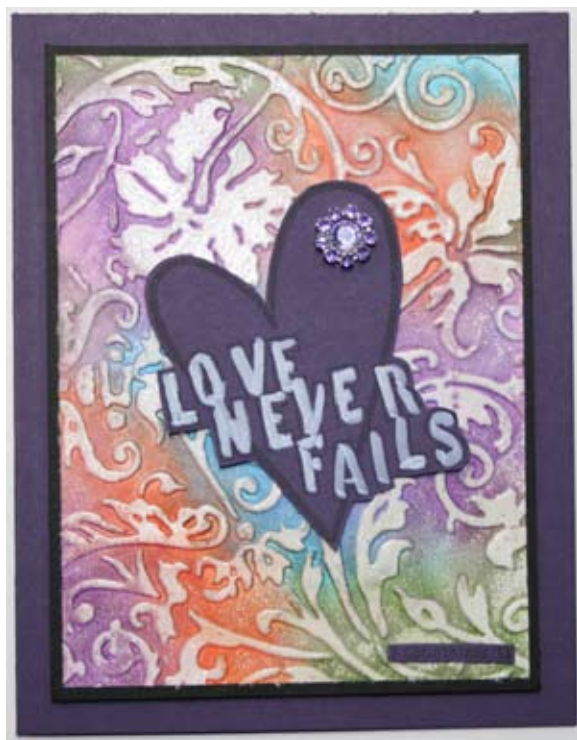
