Designer Paper Starburst Tutorial

Jane Bosi filmed this happy technique.



Supplies:

- Paper Trimmer
- 3-5 Designer Papers
- Scissors
- Adhesive
- 4" x 5 1/4" Black Cardstock



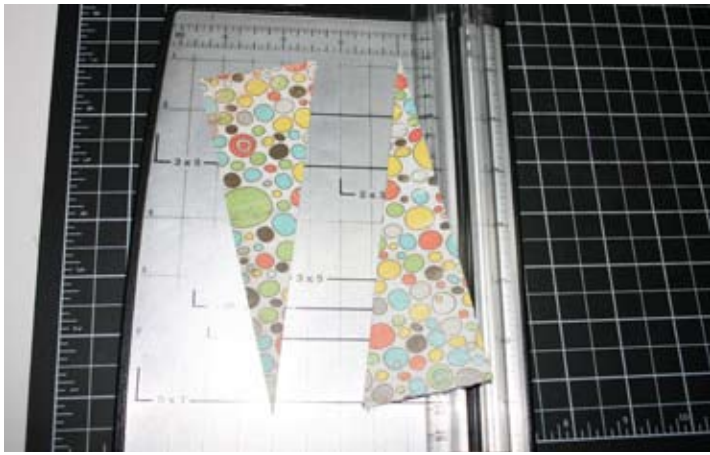
Step One:

Trim designer papers into 1" x 6" and 2" x 6" strips. A combination of 3-5 strips are necessary.



Step Two:

Separate each 6" strip into triangled halves. Align two opposing corners in the trimmer's cutting guide and slice.



Step Two Continued



Step Four:

Adhere the first triangle to the black cardstock diagonally. Allow the designer paper to overhang the black cardstock.



Step Six:

Continue adhering designer triangles, making sure to anchor the thinner point of each in the same corner of the cardstock.



Step Three:

Cut all strips in half in the same manner.



Step Five:

Position the second designer triangle next to the first, allowing for a 1/8" space between.



Step Seven:

Each triangle piece should extend beyond the edges of the black cardstock. Add designer triangles until the cardstock is covered.



Step Eight:

Trim excess.
