
Paint Transfer Tutorial

Jane Bosi filmed this easy technique.




Supplies:

- Rubber or Digital Stamp
- Scissors
- Adirondack Acrylic Paint Dabber
- Water Mister
- White Cardstock
- Photocopy Machine, not pictured




Step One:

Stamp image or print digital image.



Step Two:

Copy image using photocopy machine.



Step Three:

Trim around copy of image using scissors. Set aside.



Step Five:

Place trimmed image into wet paint. Allow to dry completely.



Step Seven:

Allow water to penetrate copy paper for a few moments. Gently rub wet areas with finger to remove paper.



Step Four:

Cover cardstock with acrylic paint using paint dabber.



Step Six:

Lightly spritz dried image with water once or twice.



Step Eight:

Rubbing too hard, or without enough moisture, will result in the removal of the image as well.



Step Nine:

Remoisten and rub copy paper as needed.



Step Eleven:

Use piece as desired.




Step Ten:

Continue removing copy paper until all has been discarded.
