Beth Norman filmed this fun technique to use Washi Tape in a new way.




Supplies:

- Washi Tape
- Scissors
- Cardstock/Card Base
- Stamps and Ink



Step One:


Stamp a focal point image on the center of the cardstock, or adhere a matted stamped image to the center.



Step Two:

Add a strip of Washi tape vertically along the top edge of the cardstock. The tape should go down just slightly past the top of the image without covering any of it.

Step Three:

Continue adding Washi tape along the top edge of the cardstock, staggering the length of each tape piece.
