Supplies:


- Four 4" x 4" Cork Pieces
- Four 4" x 4" Chipboard Pieces
- Four 4" x 4" Designer Paper Pieces
- Mod Podge or Perfect Paper Adhesive
- Foam Brushes
- Trimmer or Scissors

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Step One:

Using the foam brush, cover the top of one of the cork pieces with Mod Podge or Perfect Paper Adhesive.



Step Three:

Press the chipboard onto the cork firmly. Allow the pieces to dry for 10 minutes.



Step Five:

Adhere the paper to the chipboard, lining up the edges carefully. Set aside to dry for 10 minutes.



Step Two:

Adhere a chipboard piece to the cork.



Step Four:

Paint the back of one of the designer paper sheets and the top of the chipboard with Mod Podge/Perfect Paper Adhesive.



Step Five Continued

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Step Six:

Paint over the top and sides of the coaster with the Modge Podge/Perfect Paper Adhesive. Allow to dry and cover again with another layer to seal the paper.

Repeat with other coaster sheets and use as desired.
