Supplies:

- White Cardstock
- Background Stamp
- VersaMark Ink Pad
- Clear Embossing Powder
- Heat Tool
- Dylusions Sprays
- Mister filled with water
- Scratch Paper
- Paper Towel or Tissue (not pictured)

Step One:

Ink the background stamp with VersaMark. Stamp onto white cardstock. Clean off the stamp.



Step Three:

Melt the powder on the white cardstock with the heat tool.



Step Five:

Spray one color of Dylusions in random areas on the white cardstock. Leave some areas white.



Step Two:

Place the white cardstock onto scratch paper and cover with clear embossing powder. Carefully lift cardstock, shake off excess and return the excess powder to the container.



Step Four:

Lightly mist the white cardstock with water.



Step Six:

Spray second color of Dylusions onto white areas. If a third color is desired, leave some areas white, then spray with the third color.

Step Seven:

Wipe the Dylusions off the embossed areas with a paper towel or tissue. Let the piece dry and use as desired.
