

## Shaped Stencils Tutorial

*Combining a stencil with a die cut shape results in a great multi-layered look.

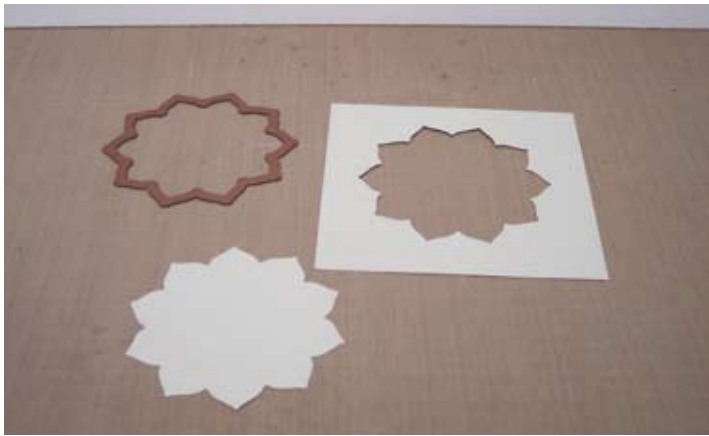

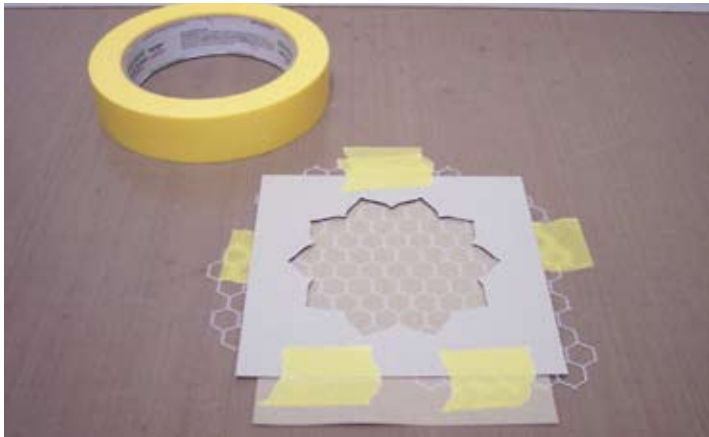
### Supplies:

- Low Tack Painter's Tape
- Cardstock - 2 pieces
- Ink Pad
- Sponge or Stipple Brush
- Large Shaped Die and Cutting Machine (not pictured) or Punch
- Nonstick Craft Mat



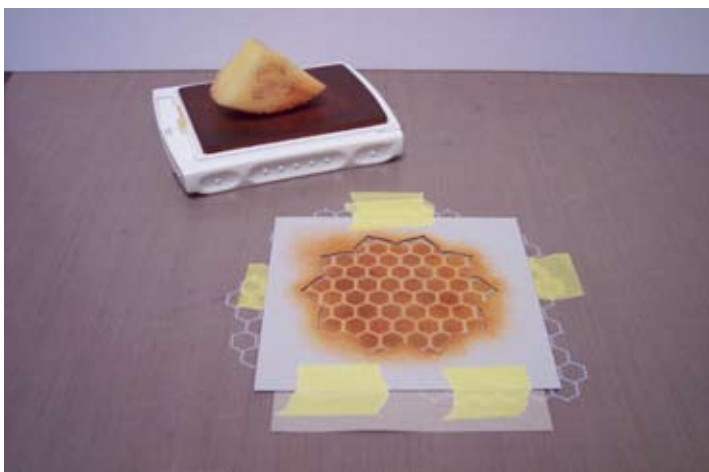
### Step One:

Place shaped die in the center of cardstock. Cut cardstock with the shaped die. Set aside the die cut for another use. The die cut negative will be used for this technique.



### Step Three:

Place the die cut negative piece over the stencil and tape it down with the low tack painter's tape.



### Step Five:

Continue sponging/stippling the ink over the stencil until the entire die cut area is filled in.



### Step Two:

Place the second cardstock piece on the nonstick craft mat. Place stencil over cardstock. Tape the edges of the stencil with the low tack painter's tape to secure it for stencilling.



### Step Four:

Ink the sponge or stipple brush with ink. Press sponge/brush down onto the exposed stencil. Tap the sponge/brush over the stencil. Do not rub back and forth - this may cause the stencil to move and/or tear.



### Step Six:

Carefully remove the tape and remove the die cut negative and stencil. Wash the ink off the stencil. This area can be stamped over directly. Finish as desired.
