
### Finished Card:

Artist: Pat Huntoon  
Stamps: Technique Junkies




### Supplies:

- Cardstock
- Black Ink
- Grey, Beige or Sand Colored Ink
- Focal Image for repeating on cardstock
- Colored Pencils, Markers or other Coloring Tools
- Stamp Positioner (optional)




### Step One:

Ink the stamp with black ink. Stamp the image on the cardstock on the bottom third of the paper, with the left edge of the image centered on the cardstock. Clean the stamp.




### Step Three:

Stamp a third image on the other side of the black image, keeping in mind that this may be a partial image.



### Step Five:

Color the black-ink image with the colored pencils or markers. Finish card as desired.



### Step Two:

Ink the stamp with the light-colored ink. Stamp the image next to the original image, with  $\frac{1}{8}$ " -  $\frac{1}{4}$ " between the images. Use a stamp positioner if necessary to keep the images in line.



### Step Four:

Continue adding images until there is a line of images along the cardstock, edge to edge.
