Supplies:


- Cardstock
- Stencil (plastic or brass)
- Dylusions Sprays 2 or 3 colors
- Nonstick Craft Mat

Step One:

Place stencil over cardstock on the nonstick craft mat.



Step Three:

Spray second color of Dylusions over the stencil in the center third. Leave the top area white.



Step Five:

Carefully lift the stencil off the cardstock. Clean the stencil with running water; pat dry with paper towels. Carefully remove the cardstock from the nonstick craft mat and set aside to dry; clean the craft mat. Once dry, use as desired. © Patricia Huntoon



Step Two:

Spray one color of Dylusions over the stencil, on the bottom third. Leave the top area white.



Step Four:

Spray the third color of Dylusions over the remaining white portion of the cardstock.
