

## Stencil Spray with a Twist Tutorial

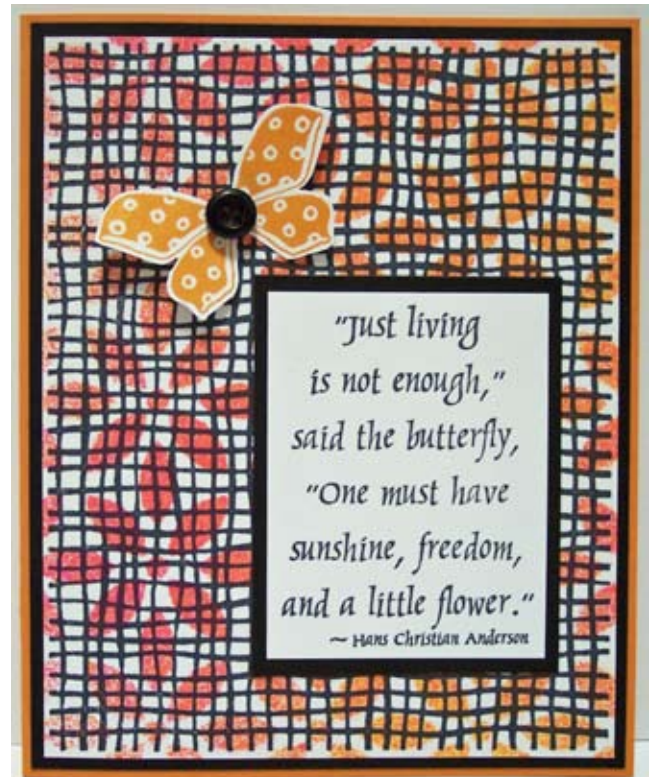
*This is a fun twist on the Stencil Spray Fun technique. By adding a background stamp to the mix, you can achieve a totally different look.*

### Finished Card:

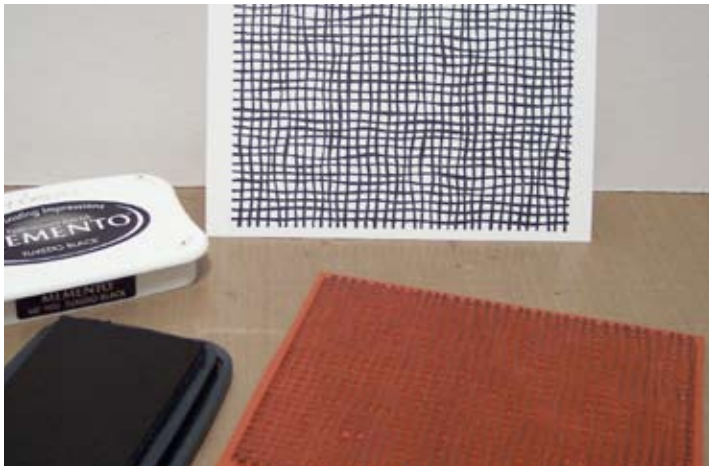

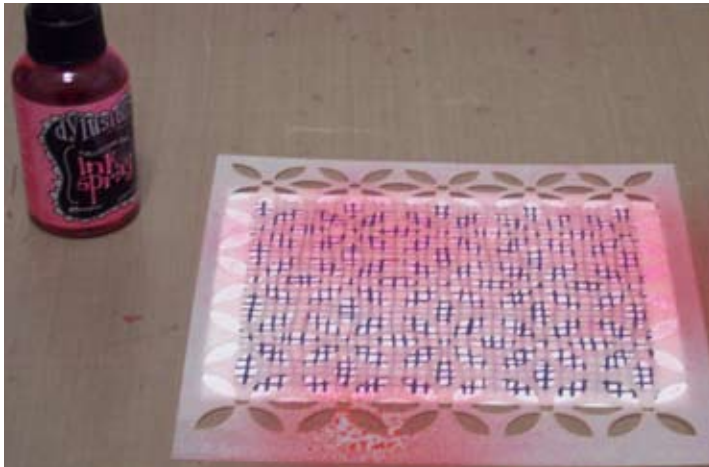
### Supplies:

- Cardstock
- Stencil (plastic or brass)
- Dylusions Sprays - 2 or 3 colors
- Background Stamp
- Ink Pad
- Nonstick craft mat



### Step One:

Ink the background stamp and stamp on the cardstock. Clean the stamp.



### Step Three:

Spray one color of Dylusions over the stencil. Leave some areas without spray.



### Step Five:

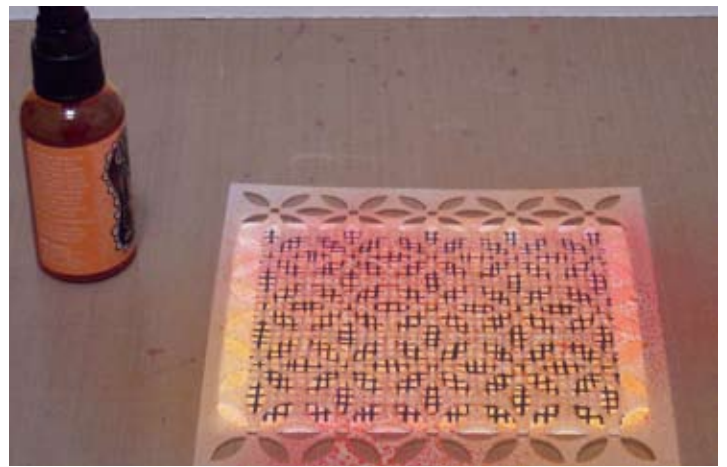
Carefully lift the stencil off the cardstock. Clean the stencil with running water; pat dry with paper towels. Carefully remove the cardstock from the nonstick craft mat and set aside to dry; clean the craft mat. Once dry, use as desired.

### Step Two:

Place stamped cardstock on nonstick craft mat. Place the stencil over the cardstock.



### Step Four:

Spray second color of Dylusions over the stencil. Fill in all "blank" areas. If using a third color, do NOT fill in all "blank" areas. Fill those in with the third color.
