Finished Card:

Artist: Beth Norman Stamps: Technique Junkies Stamps



Supplies: - Wide Washi Tape

- Circle Punch or Die
- Punch or Die for Center of Flower
- Cardstock Scrap
- Scissors
- Pop Dots
- Stamps

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Step One:

Punch out a circle from the cardstock scrap.



Step Three:

Fold the tape back over the 1" portion. Adhere another inch and fold back to create an accordion.



Step Four Continued




Step Two:

Place 1" of Washi Tape approximately 1/4" from the edge of the circle.



Step Four:

Continue with the accordion, moving around the circle to the end. Cut the end of the tape so there is just enough to tuck under the beginning of the accordion.



Step Five:

Cut cardstock for the center of the rosette.

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Step Six:

Stamp and decorate as desired. Rosette is now ready to be placed onto your project or card.
