

# Bingo Blast Tutorial



Kathie McGuire created and filmed this easy technique that uses one simple key item -- a bingo marker. The original technique this was based on uses Ranger Acrylic Paint Dabbers. You can do the technique with the dabbers, paint dabbers, Moonglow Dabbers, or Radiant Rain Dabbers. While the technique can be used with the dabbers, the difference between the bingo markers and the paints is that the markers are translucent and don't need drying between layers. The paint tends to be opaque, and needs to be dried or heat set before changing colors.



# Supplies:

- 2 or more colors of Bingo Daubers (or Ranger's Acrylic Paint Dabbers, Moonglow Dabbers or Radiant Rain Dabbers)
- Watercolor Paper (Use glossy or regular paper with anything other than the bingo dabbers)
- Spray Bottle with Water
- Scrap Paper



### Step One:

Prime the first bingo dauber by gently squeezing the bottle while pressing the tip onto a piece of scrap paper. Lift the bottle slightly off the paper and gently squeeze again, then turn the bottle upright, keeping the excess solution on the pad of the bottle's tip.



### Step Two:

Spray the tip of the dauber with two or three squirts of water.




Step Three:
Turn the Bingo Dauber upside down and hit the tip onto the watercolor paper. If the result of the splatter is small or it doesn't spread into a burst pattern, more water may be necessary when spraying the tip. Spray the tip again and repeat the process directly on top of the last area, hitting the paper more forcefully.



# Step Five:

Allow the piece to dry. Finish as desired.



Step Four:
Repeat steps one through three with the second and third colors of daubers.






