Stenciled Collage Tutorial

This really ramps up the look of both the stencil and the collage stamp. It's easy and has stunning results! Filmed by Holly Brown.



Supplies:

- Collage Stamp
- Smooth White Cardstock (must be larger than stamp)
- Permanent Black or Gray Ink (StazOn Jet Black used here)
- 2 or 3 colors of Ink
- Sponges or Daubers
- Plastic Stencil (must be larger than the stamped image)
- Removable Low-tack Tape
- Non-stick Craft Sheet



Step One:

Stamp the collage with permanent black ink on the white cardstock. Let it dry completely (5 minutes). Clean ink off stamp.



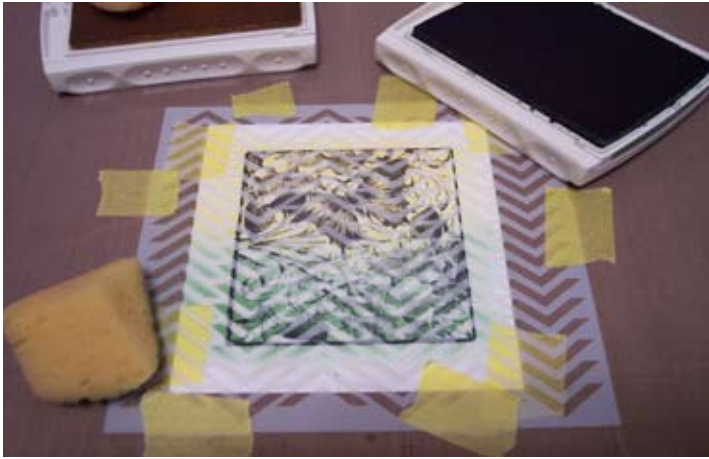
Step Two:

Tape the edges of the stamped white cardstock to the non-stick craft mat using removable low-tack tape.



Step Three:

Place the plastic stencil over the stamped image. Tape the edges of the plastic stencil to the non-stick craft mat using the removable low-tack tape.



Step Five:

Sponge the second color of ink across the bottom of the collage. If a third color is used, sponge it in the middle. Use light pressure.



Step Seven:

Remove the tape from the white cardstock and trim the stenciled collage image. Use as desired.



Step Four:

Sponge one color of ink across the top of the collage. Use light pressure - do not move the stencil.



Step Six:

Remove the tape from the plastic stencil and pull the stencil off the stamped image. Wash the stencil with water and dry completely.

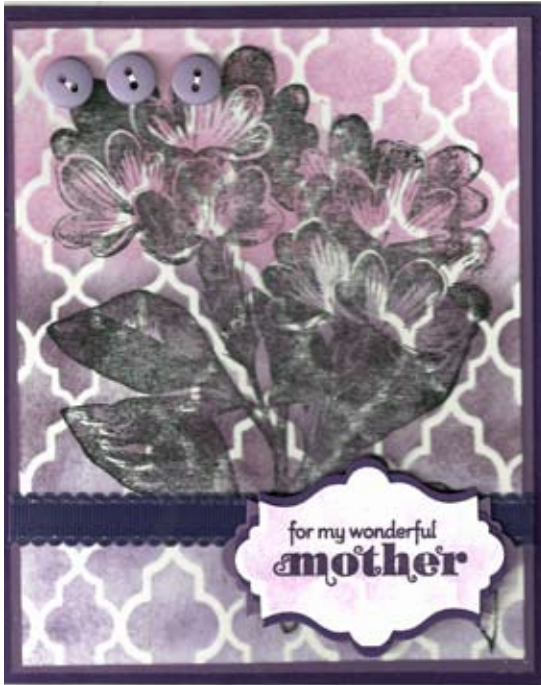

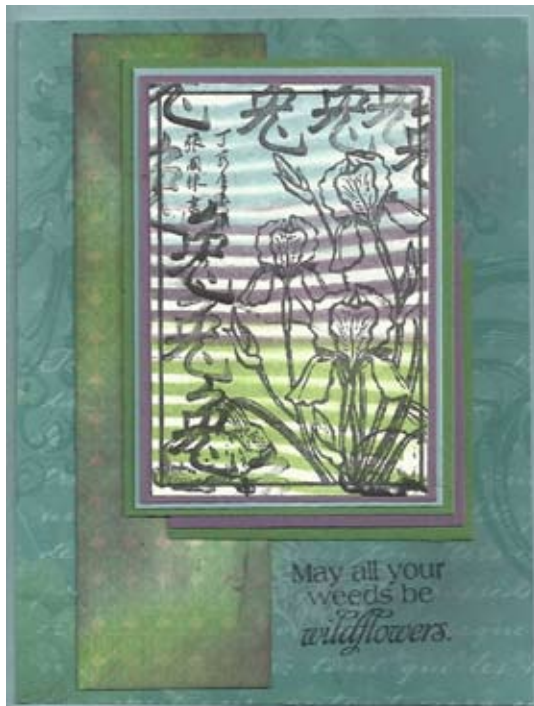
