



Step Three:

Die cut the colored cardstock using all the dies that will be used as frames. Keep the cardstock in place.




Step Five:

Turn the die pieces back to the front so the tape is on the back.



Step Seven:

Remove the cut piece; use the interior section for a different project. Remove the tape from the remaining frame.



Step Four:

If possible, remove some of the tackiness from the painter's tape by rubbing against a cloth or clothing. Place the tape over the die and cardstock on the cutting side of the die.



Step Six:

Working on a cutting surface, use the Xacto knife to cut along the inside area of the die. Cut through the cardstock and tape.



Step Eight:

Place adhesive on the back of the frames and adhere to the cardstock over the areas to be highlighted.




Step Nine:

Trim the piece. If adding color, apply to the highlighted areas only. Mat and embellish as desired.




