

Drips Tutorial

Here is another use for your reinkers! Filmed by Ann Clack.

Finished Card:

Artist: Ann Clack



Supplies:

- Reinkers or refills, 4—6 colors
- Eye Dropper
- Watercolor paper, 90—140 lb.
- Paint Palette with at least 6 compartments
- Craft Sheet
- Paper Towel
- Container for clean water



Step One:

Put one drop of each color on the palette. Each color gets its own section.



Step Two:

Add approximately 10 drops of water to each ink color.



Step Three:

With eye dropper, start dripping color at the top of the water-color paper.



Step Four:

Allow the drip to travel all the way to the bottom of the paper. Tip the paper back and forth to alter the course of the ink.



Step Five:

Using the paper towel, wick off the excess ink at the bottom of the paper.



Step Six:

Drop two or three lines of each color tipping the paper as the drips run down.



Step Seven:

If desired, add more color lines once the original lines are dry. You can also rotate the paper to drip from the opposite end if desired.

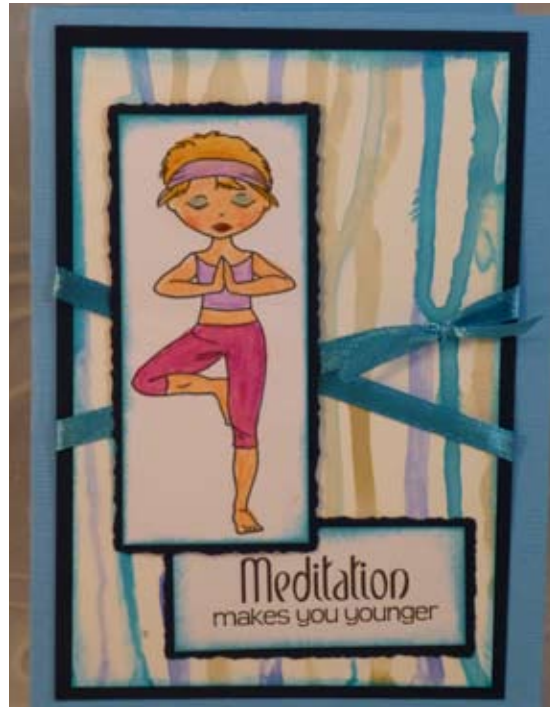
