Stickers Galore Tutorial

Hetty Sanders created this fun tutorial for using leftover stickers to create great backgrounds. She shows us several options for different looks. The ideas can be combined to maximize the stickers even more!



Supplies:

- Leftover Sticker Sheets
- Cardstock

Optional Items:

- Embossing Machine with Embossing Folders
- Gesso or other Paints with Brush
- Ink

Idea One: One Sheet of Stickers



Step One:

Apply numbers and images from the leftover sticker sheets, overlapping the pieces.



Step Two:

Completely cover the cardstock.



Step Three:

Cut to size and use as desired.

Idea Two: Embossed Theme



Step One:

Occasionally a word will remain on the sticker sheet. Add image stickers to complement the word.



Step Three:

Add ink over highlighted area, if desired, and use as background piece.



Step Two:

Emboss the cardstock, if desired.

Idea Three: Several Sticker Sheets with Gesso



Step One:

Use a few different sets and stick randomly on the cardstock.



Step Three:

The gesso softens the background. When the paint is dry, the background can be stamped on directly.



Step Two:

Add gesso to the background piece with a foam brush.
