

## Burnished Tie Dye Tutorial

*This colorful technique makes beautiful backgrounds. Filmed by Ann Clack.*

### Finished Card:

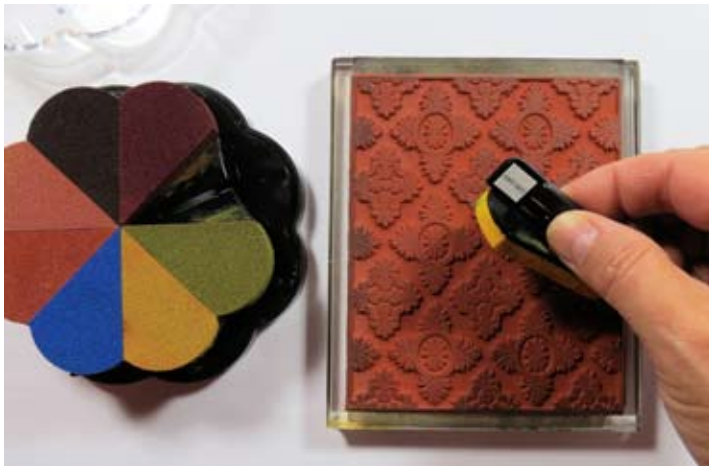

Stamps: Technique Junkies Stamps



### Supplies:

- Background or Medallion Stamp
- Cardstock
- 3 Pigment Inks (light, medium, dark)
- 3 Dye Inks (to match inks above)
- Blending Tools
- Clear Embossing Powder
- Heat Tool (not pictured)



### Step One:

Starting with the lightest color of pigment ink, sponge the center of the image.



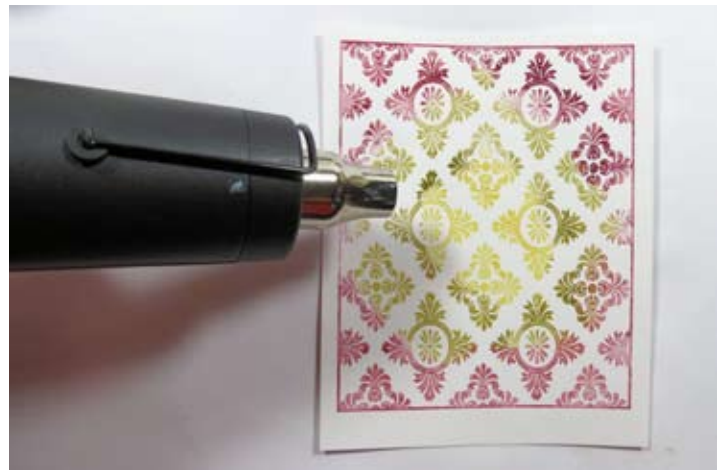
### Step Two:

Sponge the medium pigment ink color around the lightest color. Finish with the darkest color around the outside edges.



### Step Three:

Cover image with clear embossing powder.



### Step Four:

Heat with heat tool until all embossing powder is melted.



### Step Five:

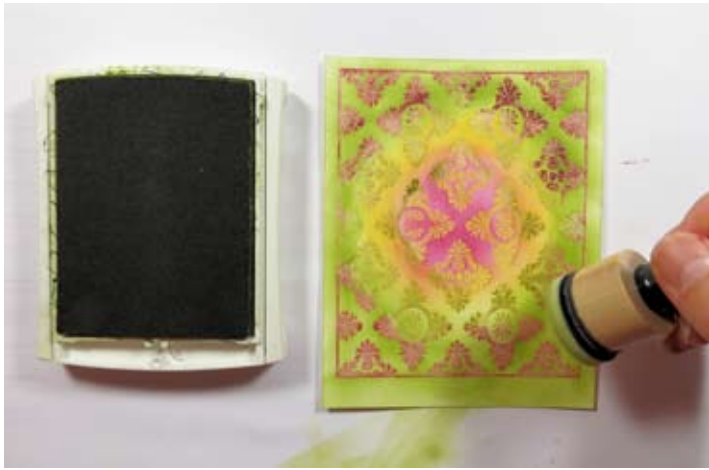
Using blending tool, sponge the darkest dye ink color on the lightest color of the image.



### Step Six:

Sponge the lightest color of dye ink over the medium color of the image.





## Step Seven:

Sponge the medium dye ink over the darkest color of the image.



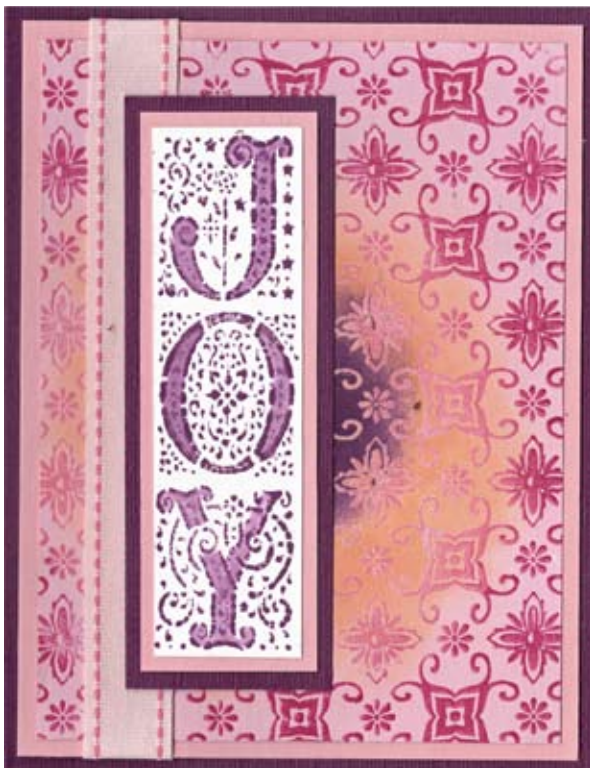
## Step Eight:

Use as desired.

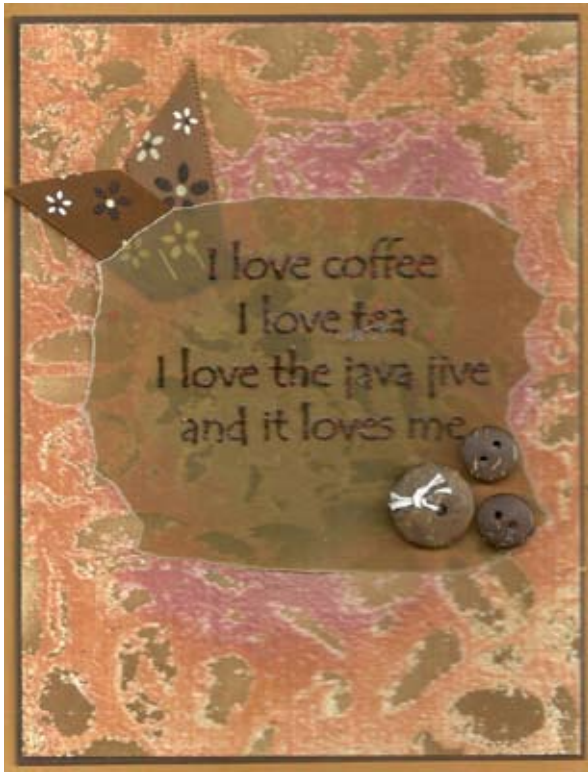
