This has really nice dimension. Filmed by Jane Bosi.

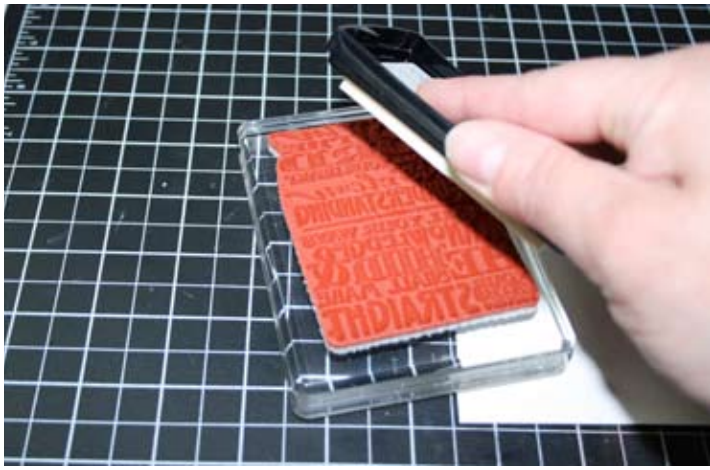
Finished Card:

Artist: Jane Bosi
Stamps: Impression Obsession



Supplies:

- Watercolor Paper
- Sentiment Stamp
- Flourish Stamp
- Distress Inks
- VersaMark Ink
- White Embossing Powder
- Heat Tool
- Water Spritzer
- Paper Towel, not pictured



Step One:

Ink sentiment stamp with Versamark ink and stamp onto watercolor paper.

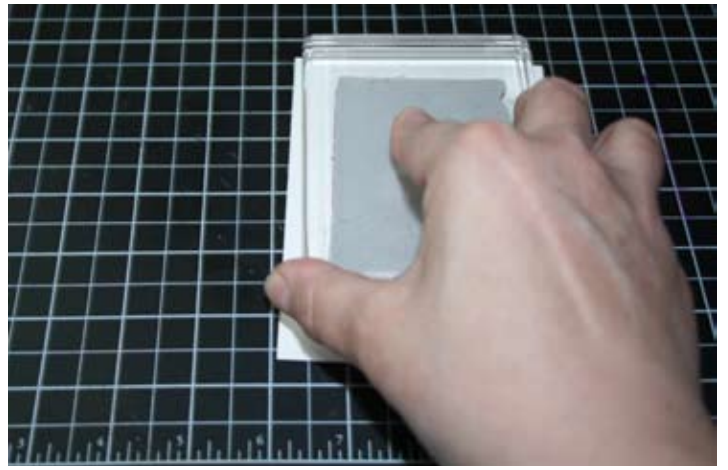


Step Two:

Cover sentiment with embossing powder.

Step One, Continued



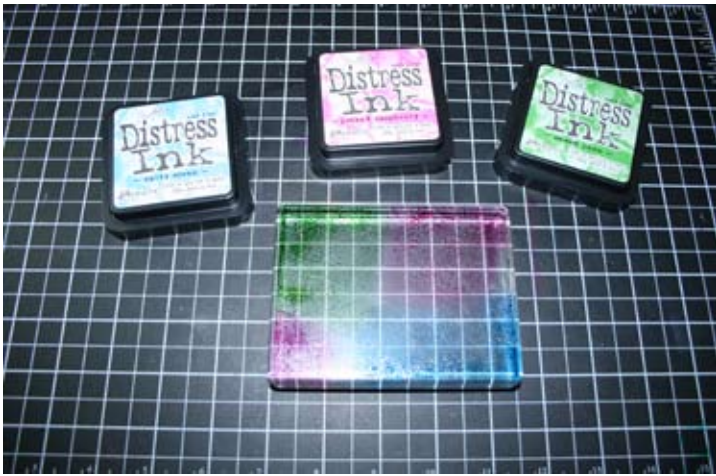
Step Three:

Remove excess embossing powder and heat emboss sentiment.

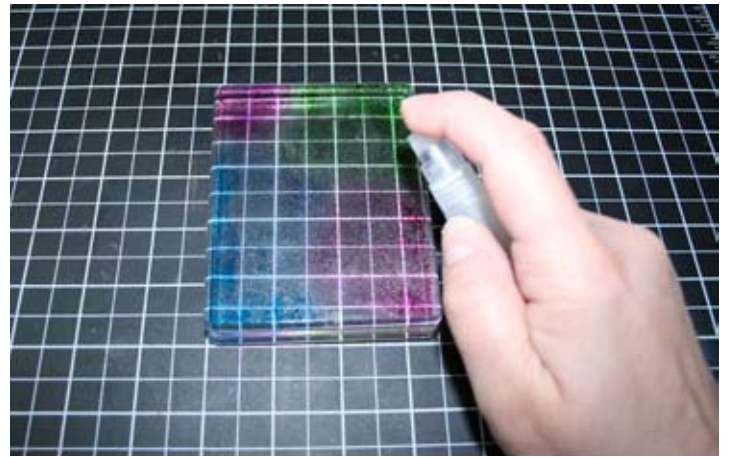


Step Four:

Apply a variety of distress ink to a large acrylic block.



Step Four, Continued



Step Five:

Spritz inked block with liberal amount of water.



Step Five Continued



Step Six:

Apply inked block over the top of the embossed sentiment.



Step Seven:

Use finger, if necessary, to move ink around and fill in open spots.



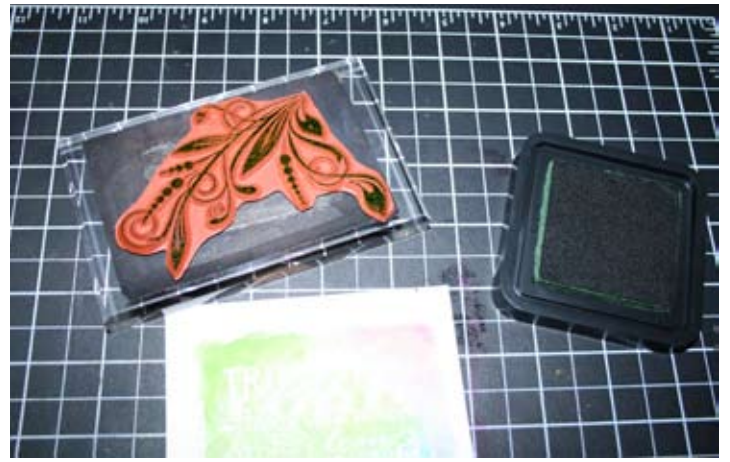
Step Eight:

Rub a paper towel over sentiment to remove excess inks.



Step Nine:

Allow to dry completely.



Step Ten:

Ink flourish in a dark/contrasting color and stamp, as desired, over embossed sentiment.



Step Ten, Continued



Step Eleven:

Again, rub paper towel over piece to remove excess ink from embossed areas.



Step Twelve:

Use as desired.

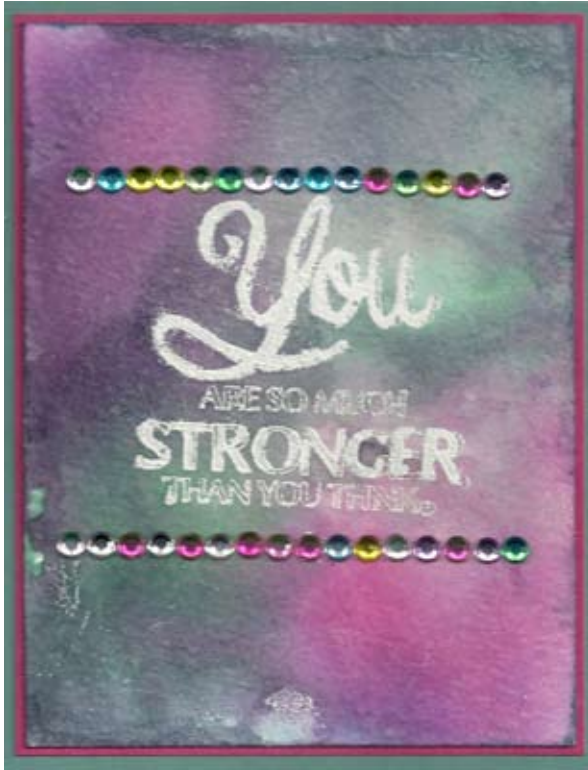
