


Triangular Zig-Zag Tutorial Cutting the background into triangles really adds fun dimension.

Finished Card:

Artist: Beth Norman Stamps: Technique Junkies Stamps



Supplies:

- 4" x 5 1/4" White Cardstock
- 4" x 6" Designer Paper
- Adhesive
- Paper Trimmer

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Step One:

Place the designer paper into the paper trimmer with the long side at the top. Cut into four $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.



Step Three:

Cut all four pieces.




Step Five:

Place the second triangle under the top triangle. Leave space between the two triangles. Adhere.




Step Two:

Line up the top right and bottom left corners onto paper trimmer and cut into triangles.



Step Four:

Place first triangle along the top of the white cardstock and adhere.



Step Six:

Continue placing and adhering triangles until the white cardstock is covered. Finish project as desired


