Becky Partan, owner of My Paper Moon (www.mypapermoon.com), was the first to suggest this technique and send some samples (at least a year ago!). Since then, this has been suggested often by others, too. The foil-covered cardstock is gorgeous with alcohol ink coloring and the texture of the Cuttlebug (dry embossing). Thank you to Becky and to everyone else who suggested it, too!



# Supplies:

- 2 or 3 colors of Alcohol Ink
- Xyron or Double-sided Tape
- Cardstock (any color)
- Alcohol Ink Applicator or Cosmetic Sponge
- Blending Solution
- StazOn Ink
- Cuttlebug with Embossing Folder, Big Shot with Texture Plate, or other Texture/Embossing Tool



## Step One:

Place Xyron adhesive or double-sided adhesive on the cardstock.



# Step Two:

Tear off a piece of foil larger than the cardstock.



Step Three:
Remove any protective backing from the adhesive-covered cardstock. Flatten the foil on the work surface and attach the cardstock to it. Flatten and smooth foil.




# Step Five:

Place two or three drops of the first ink on the cosmetic sponge/ alcohol ink applicator.



Step Seven:
Close the page protector and gently rub the inks together inside. Open the protector.



Step Four:
Wrap excess foil around the edges of the paper temporarily.



# Step Six:

Place two drops of the second ink color in the ink applicator next to the first color.



Step Eight:
Pounce the inks onto the foil, twisting while pouncing to blending and move the colors.



Step Nine:
Allow the inks to dry.

Step Seven:

Trim to project size and use as desired on final piece.




**StepTen:**Place the foil-colored cardstock into an embossing folder and emboss using the Cuttlebug/embossing machine.




Step Eleven:
Gently rub the StazOn ink over the raised areas of the foil to apply ink to the textured areas.




